

Archway improvements

Works planned at Archway gyratory and on Archway Road from 27 May

We are transforming Archway to create a new public space and introduce a new two-way traffic system.

Archway gyratory

Carriageway and footway works are continuing: from 27 May, the footway along St John's Way and Sandridge Street at the gyratory will be temporarily closed until late July. Bus stop R for services to Holloway will also be temporarily relocated to Holloway Road. The section of footway from Highgate Hill to Archway Road will re-open from 27 May.

Archway Road

The western footway will remain closed between the gyratory and Lidyard Road until early July. Bus stop G is temporarily suspended during these works. The nearest alternative stops for services towards East Finchley or Muswell Hill are stop D on Highgate Hill or stop X on Archway Road.

After these works have been completed, construction of the new central reservation will start on Archway Road.

Pedestrian diversion routes and alternative crossing points will be clearly signed.
