

# Archway improvements

## Works planned at Archway gyratory and on Archway Road from 27 June

We are transforming Archway to create a new public space and introduce a two-way traffic system.

### Archway gyratory

Works to construct the new carriageway, pavement and a traffic island are continuing on Sandridge Street at the gyratory. Bus stop R for services to Holloway has been temporarily relocated to Holloway Road. These works are expected to continue until early August.

From Monday 27 June we will also start to construct pavement on the western side of St John's Way. These pavement works will take three weeks to complete.

### Archway Road

Construction of the new central reservation is progressing well and we expect these works to be completed in early July. We will then start construction of the new pavement and cycle track on the eastern side of Archway Road.

Pedestrian diversion routes and alternative crossing points will be clearly signed.
